Space Coast Area Transit Announces Fixed Route Bus Changes

Annually Space Coast Area Transit reviews their Fixed Route Bus Service for time schedule and route adjustments. Many of these changes are to keep the bus service running efficiently and on-time. Effective April 3, 2010, Space Coast Area Transit will be initiating the following route changes to their Fixed Route Bus Service.

Route 1

- Route 1 will no longer serve the Courthouse on Nieman Avenue. The bus will stay on Babcock Street in both directions.
- When heading northbound, Route 1 will no longer travel eastbound on Aurora Rd.
- Route 1 will no longer go into the Port St. John Plaza and Burger King on the southbound trip. The bus stop will be on US 1.

Route 2

- Route 2 will no longer travel on US 1 at Country Club Drive. The bus will pull into Searstown Mall and stop at the main entrance for Bealls.
- When leaving Searstown Mall, the bus will turn left onto Country Club Drive, right on Hopkins Avenue, then right onto Grave Avenue. Route 2 will stop where it is safe on Hopkins Avenue.
- The departure time from Wal-Mart will be 5 minutes earlier, at :25 after the hour.
- Route 2 will no longer stop in the driveway at the Titusville Highrise. The bus will stop on the street at the Titusville Highrise.

Route 6

- Cocoa Loop – Route 6 will no longer travel on Lake Drive. The bus will continue on Clearlake Road to SR 520 to Varr Avenue.
- Rockledge Loop – Route 6 will no longer travel on Jackson Street and Pluckebaum Drive, riders can catch the bus at new bus stops on SR 520 or Fiske Blvd.
- Route 6 will no longer use Orange Avenue. The bus stop for Wuesthoff Hospital will now be at Seminole Drive and Orange Avenue.

Route 23

- The Route 23 loop with Glendale, Wakeforest and Dallam will now be serviced after the bus leaves Palm Bay West.

Route 27

- Route 27 will no longer serve Wal-Mart at the door; riders can access Wal-Mart via Route 25.
- The bus will not travel on Robert J. Conlan Blvd.

Route 28

- Route 28 will make a left on Lake Washington Road and travel straight to Wickham Road from Stewart. It will not travel on Parkway or Croton Road.
